### **Member reports:**

Verna: 5/30 flags ready to go for next Friday.

Bonnie: Will let everyone know about the calendar change – including Purdums (corn) and Elementary School (location).

Willa: Funding for new uniforms announced. Anyone who has not been measured needs to be. Willa mentioned that she went to web page to print a trailer sponsor form; web page needs to be updated. Joel says Ken is working to move to a new website. A few students do not have spangles and helmets – will need to get them out before the first game.

Kurt: Vinyl for the sidewalk is cut and chain to hold it down was about ½ the cost of what he expected. Needs to get it on the field and measure it. Each section will be about 100 pounds and there are four sections.

### **Old/New Business: Rob Uriu**

- 1<sup>st</sup> home game – Leigh Simmons will be in charge of water for the students
- Carwash – need some parent volunteers to supervise
- Dutch Oven update: tickets are being pre-sold for \$20.00. Envelopes will be sent home with the students, buyers will prepay and Bonnie will send tickets home. They will have about 2 weeks to sell. Students normally make about 50% of the ticket price. There will be a silent auction and a live auction. Baskets will be Disney themed and the students will work on that. Needs include adults to help set-up, serve, and clean-up.

**Band Director's Report: Joel Williams**

Uniform update – showed a picture of the uniform and explained the design and style options. Can go with sleeved or sleeveless jackets that could be worn with compression shirts underneath in various colors. Plumes can be replaced in different colors to change the looks as the band wants. Same with hip drop and reflective part on the front of the jacket. Joel is having drawings done of a mock uniform before the decision is made. Will be ordering the uniforms soon – but 180-day turn around. Looking to purchase 130 uniforms. School district board told Joel that they can help with some of the smaller items.

A few rehearsals have been held already. Next week, practices will pick up. Monday they will play at the Freshman assembly, and practice.

Explained Bucks for the Band. 3 groups of students will parade through 3 subdivisions and play for donations. Money goes into the “war chest” for bands expenses.
