**SECRETARY REPORT:** read by Ken Simmons, notes from April 12 meeting.  
Motion to approve as read Jill Stephens (Debbie Westfall); passed

**TREASURER REPORT:** Jill Stephens

1. Budget proposal passed out – see attached paper
2. Need to reduce expenses if we can. One example, try to get tv donated
3. Need to put money into uniform fund
4. Need to be creative in generating funds
  - a. Spinning wheel at Fruitland Fun Day
5. Current account balance for boosters is between \$8000 - \$9000.
6. Joel would like \$5000 moved to uniform fund
  - a. Jill – money in the account will enable us to start writing grant proposals
7. Joel's wish list includes purchase of 5 trombones, approx. \$500 each
8. Leigh asked about color guard wishes for purchase, about \$2000.
9. Joel: need to get around the West Ada lawsuit by adding cost of the trip and the band fee together. Also, Teresa Fabricius may have some funds available. Hoping for \$5000 – 6000.
  - a. Extra day should not affect cost of trip per Joel's conversation with Catherine ; trip with band fee around \$650.

Rob – what total from boosters needed for the guard and trombones, what can we afford to transfer to uniform fund?

1. Joel – in the past, flags about \$1500. Guard needs about \$2500.
2. Jill – we need to make sure we have the money available before we spend it. Budget is a projection of possible funds generated from fundraisers, not a guarantee.

Kevin: move to approve budget with priority items to be purchased, second Debbie Westfall.
